Basic Qualification (ABQ) Courses for Graduating Pre-

service Students in Ontario

This correspondence is in response to a request for clarification regarding the ability of Ontario faculties of education to be able to offer additional qualification courses in the May-June intersession period to pre-service students graduating in Ontario.

The issue of admitting recent pre-service teacher education graduates to ABQ courses (schedule A) during the intersession period was previously considered by the College. Regulation 184/97, Teachers' Qualifications, enables pre-service teacher candidates who have been recommended by their deans for certification to take ABQ courses during intersession (May and June).

As in the past, in order to assist in the process of providing teacher candidates who have been recommended by their deans for certification with increased knowledge and skills, the College is prepared to accommodate the enrolment of teacher candidates in intersession Additional Qualification Courses (Schedule C and D). This decision has been made based on the understanding that faculties of education will admit only those pre-service candidates who have been recommended for certification. These candidates must also have completed the application process for a Certificate of Qualification and be members of the College prior to recommendations for additional qualifications being sent to the College.



Providers and applicants will not be required to complete conditional entry forms. The responsibility to ensure that the recent graduates are listed on the College electronic public register as members of the College prior to the recommendations for additional qualifications being sent to the College rests with the provider and the applicant. It should be noted that recommendations received for non-members of the College will not be processed in a retroactive manner.

I hope this information will assist you in the planning of your Continuing Education programs and I wish you continued success with your in-service offerings.
