REASONS FOR DECISION AND DECISION ON MOTION

Having considered the submissions of College counsel and counsel for the Member, and on consent of the parties, the Committee authorizes the College to withdraw the allegations of professional misconduct against Harmony Demelo (also known as Harminder Dulay) set out in the *Notice of Hearing* dated July 27, 2006.
