

The Committee also orders that the undertaking be attached to this Decision. The Committee is satisfied that by accepting the Undertaking of William Gostick, the public interest has been served. The Committee is also satisfied that the Professional Misconduct Regulation 1(24) provides for the protection of the public interest should the member fail to abide by his written undertaking.
