DECISION ON MOTION

Counsel for the College brought a motion to seek leave from the Committee to withdraw the allegations set out in the *Notice of Hearing* dated October 6, 2009.

Jerry Leo Schram was not in attendance.

Independent legal counsel advised the Committee that it had jurisdiction to make the order requested pursuant to Rule 13(16) of the *Rules of Procedure of the Discipline Committee*.

The Committee considered the submissions of College counsel. Upon the consent of the parties, the Committee authorizes the College to withdraw the allegations of professional misconduct against Jerry Leo Schram set out in the *Notice of Hearing* dated October 6, 2009 in exchange for the *Undertaking and Acknowledgement* of the Member as follows:

1. The Member will, immediately following the withdrawal of the *Notice of Hearing*, resign his membership in the Ontario College of Teachers and the Registrar will cancel his Certificate of Qualification and Registration.
2. The Member undertakes that he will not seek reinstatement of his Certificate of Qualification and Registration and will not teach in any public or private school in Ontario.
3. The Member understands that the Public Register of the College will reflect the fact that he resigned while he was the subject of disciplinary proceedings by the College and that his certificate has been cancelled; and that he has undertaken never to teach again in any public or private school in Ontario; and that he will never seek reinstatement of his Certificate.
4. The Member understands that any breach of any aspect of this *Undertaking and Acknowledgement* would constitute professional misconduct.

The Committee concludes that the withdrawal of the *Notice of Hearing* in exchange for the Member's *Undertaking and Acknowledgment* in these circumstances is reasonable. Publication of the terms of the Member's *Undertaking* on the Public Register helps to serve and protect the public interest.
