REASONS FOR DECISION AND DECISION ON MOTION

Counsel for the College brought a motion to seek leave from the Committee to withdraw the allegations set out in the *Notice of Hearing* dated October 18, 2006.

Independent legal counsel advised the Committee that it had jurisdiction to make the order requested, pursuant to section 4.1 of the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act*, which provides that if the parties consent, a proceeding may be disposed of by a decision of the Committee without a hearing.

Having considered the submissions of College counsel and on consent of the parties, the Committee authorizes the College to withdraw the allegations of professional misconduct and incompetence against Dale Bertram White set out in the *Notice of Hearing* dated October 18, 2006.
