Returning Materials

You can return materials

- by mail
- in person at the College
- in the secure book-return drop box anytime at the College at 101 Bloor St. West at the corner of St. Thomas. You can find the library drop box in the laneway at the back of the College building off St. Thomas Street.

Your Library Page

If you have opened a Members' Area account, login and choose Your Library to access your customized library page.

You can:

- request books and videos online from the College library and have them mailed to you free of charge
- check the status of your holds
- renew materials you've checked out.

French-language resources

The library has more than 700 French-language resources. All French-language materials are in the online catalogue including a number of French-language periodicals.

If you can't get to the College

- We'll mail books, videos and DVDs to your home or school address. Use the special-return mailing label, and you can mail books back to the library at no charge.
- Borrow up to eight items at a time, for a three-week period, and renew for up to six weeks longer.
- Request a literature search by library staff at library@oct.ca and we'll e-mail you the journal articles. Be sure to include your registration number with your request.

You can use the postage-paid return label to return books you received by mail or you can return materials in the outdoor dropbox at any time.

- government documents including Statistics Canada publications
- vertical files by subject
- newspapers, both in print and online
- several work stations with Internet access
- WiFi for your own laptop.

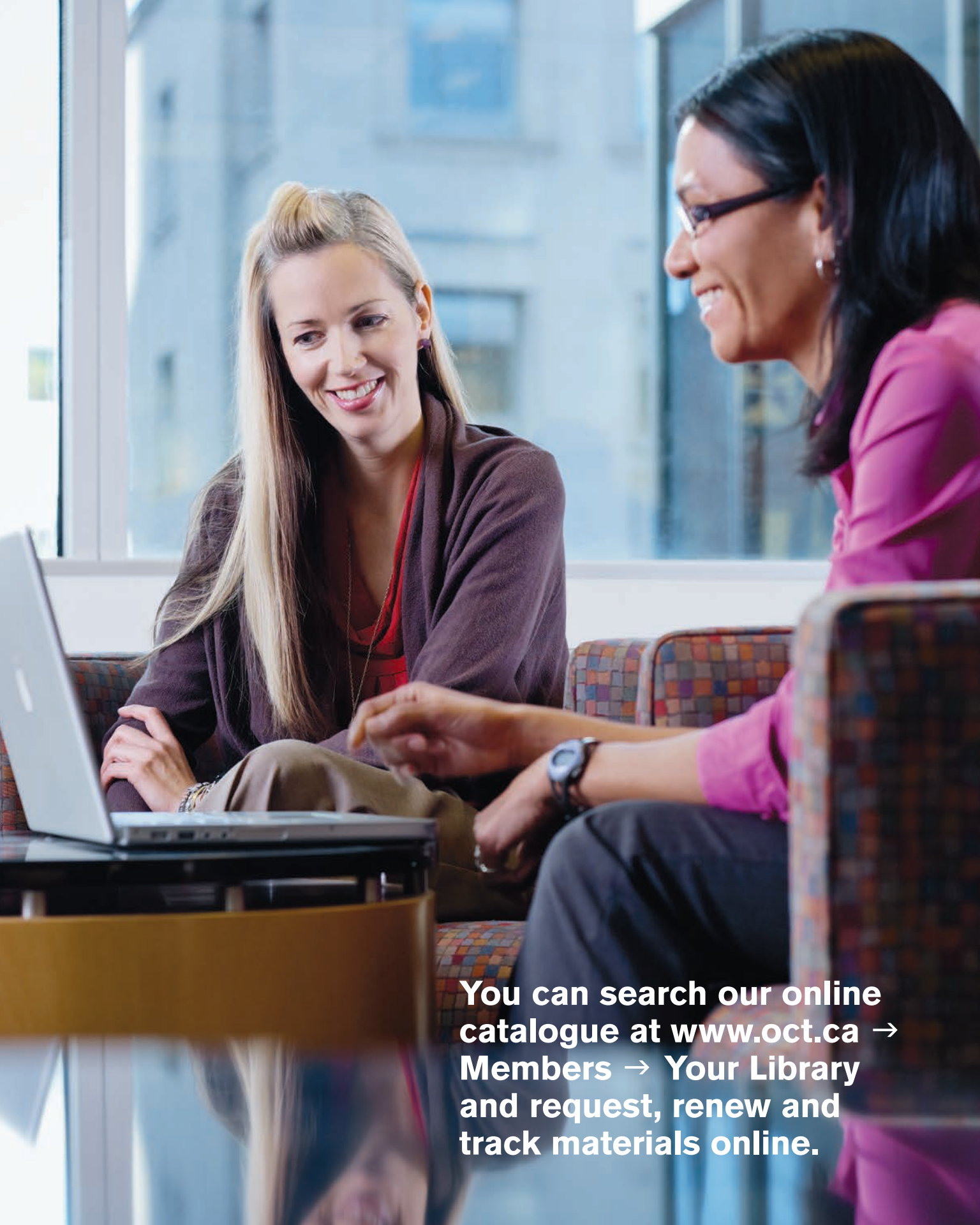
